A WELL-COORDINATED RECREATION PROJECT *Dedication ceremony and community celebration at Telfair Park in Sylmar*

WHEN: Saturday, June 28, 2008

10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

WHERE: Telfair Park

15721 Cobalt Ave., Sylmar

WHAT: Dedication of a park in the northeast San Fernando Valley community of Sylmar that was built by ValleyCrest Landscaping of Calabasas on a 1.5-acre parcel of vacant land donated by the Tessera Sylmar Homeowners Association, with ValleyCrest providing labor, plants, and materials at no cost to taxpayers. The combined value of the land and construction is several hundred thousand dollars. The project was done in cooperation with the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks, which will maintain the facility, and with the support of Councilmember Richard Alarcón. Features include a playground, picnic area, soccer field, and walking path.
